As an organisation that operates from inner Melbourne, we acknowledge the peoples of the Kulin nation, the Traditional Owners of this land. We pay our respects to their Elders, past and present. StreetSmart delivers our work on unceded land across Australia which always was, and always will be, Aboriginal land.

With acknowledgement of the importance for self-determination, StreetSmart funds and supports First Nations led organisations and their programs, where possible, to assist people experiencing homelessness and disadvantage in their communities.

In the Financial Year 2021-2022, we have supported 33 Indigenous run organisations, with 19% of grantrecipients and 34% of SleepSafe recipients identifying as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.

SIEPS/AIE ATRANSFORMATIVE COMMUNITY INITIATIVE

SleepSafe is a unique collaboration between **Sheridan Australia and** StreetSmart that aims to fund and distribute quality sheet and towel kits to people right across Australia who are at risk of or experiencing homelessness. Launched in September 2019, Sheridan staff activate the fundraising, production, and distribution of kits. and StreetSmart connects with local organisations and frontline homelessness services that can provide the kits to people in need.

Often, people accessing frontline homelessness services have very few personal possessions or practical items, and sourcing this kind of material aid is a constant struggle for organisations. SleepSafe is a unique solution to these challenges, providing quality sheets and towels to vulnerable Australians while also easing the pressure on local frontline organisations to fund and source this material aid. Each Sleep kit consists of a set of sheets, pillowcase, and towel which help provide dignity, comfort, and care to people in crisis.

Through partnering with 598 organisations, SleepSafe is making a difference for thousands of Australians including at-risk youth, Indigenous Australians, Domestic Violence survivors, and people experiencing housing insecurity. When someone receives a Sleep kit, it is theirs to own, providing care and dignity during a time of high stress and vulnerability.

Our community partners are supporting people facing intersecting challenges like homelessness, poverty, domestic violence, and unemployment, and who often seek help with few possessions.

As a high quality personal item, Sleep Kits are providing dignity, care, and comfort to people when they need it most. Through our diverse partners, kits have supported over 10,488 at-risk youth and young parents, with a third of all recipients identifying as Indigenous Australians.

Meet Sahara, Supported by the Sheridan Outlet in Joondalup who have fundraised 1,816 kits

Sahara (not their real name) was referred to Youth Furture's Housing Support Worker in May 2020. At the time, she was 17-yearsold, had a 5-week-old baby and had been in the care of child protection since she was four. Sahara moved out of a women's refuge and into the Nest program which supports young mothers escaping homelessness and domestic violence. Receiving assistance from Youth Futures programs, Sahara was ready to transition and maintain a longterm property of her own. Thanks to donations from StreetSmart and Sheridan and other organisations, Sahara said her house looked like "a minimansion" and couldn't believe it was hers.

Meet Bec, supported by the Nunawading Sheridan Store which has fundraised 4,262 kits

Bec (not their real name) came to You Matter for support through a family violence agency with her 2 young children. Bec was fleeing family violence and was seeking support in setting up a new home for herself and children. We had iust received 60 Sleep Kits from StreetSmart and Sheridan and could immediately support Bec by providing her with new sheets and towels for her family. Support like this eases the financially crippling burden that beginning a new life from scratch can hold for families like Bec's.

With the continual growth of SleepSafe partners, the program supports an incredibly diverse range of organisations on the ground in their communities. In 2023 alone, the SleepSafe recipient network has grown by 10% with over 53 new partnerships, each with their own unique network. We partner with over 104 Domestic and Family Violence services, 57 Youth services, and 179 neighbourhood and community services who support lowincome and at-risk Australians.

Second Harvest on Noongar Country (WA) By providing small but vital community organisations with free, high-quality manchester, SleepSafe saves our partners valuable time and money.

SleepSafe has saved 11,000 hours of precious staff time and \$451,000 in wage costs for our partners who provide manchester to their clients. Without SleepSafe, these partners would pay \$30, on average for sheets and a towel (of a lesser quality), which has saved the sector over 3.2 million dollars. A third of our partners usually rely on donated and second hand manchester but through SleepSafe, are able to provide their clients with the dignity of higher quality sheets and towels that last longer.

*Based on feedback provided in a recent partner survey showing that 66% of partners spent on average 3 hours per month sourcing new manchester at a staff cost of \$40 an hour.

SleepSafe connects communities, empowering Sheridan staff and their customers to raise funds for kits to be donated to their local frontline homelessness services. The program embodies the whole-of-community approach that we strongly believe in to end homelessness.

Penrith Store supporting at-risk young people through Platform Youth Services

Since 2019, the Penrith Sheridan store alone has raised enough money for **701** kits for their local organisations, one of which is Platform Youth Services who support youth in the Blue Mountains region.



Responding to Crisis

SleepSafe offers continuous support to vital grassroot organisations through the provision of material aid, however with more and more Australian communities impacted by natural disasters we have also been able to rapidly respond to crises as they arise.

Since launching, SleepSafe has provided over **5,000** kits to community organisations in flood affected areas. "The floods devastated our home and completely wiped us out. We didn't have anything. When we were handed beautiful linen sheets and towels, we shed a few tears. It was just amazing to be warm and comfortable after the stress of the past months."
