A TRANSFORMATIVE

SleepSafe is a unique collaboration between Sheridan Australia and StreetSmart that aims

to fund and distribute quality sheet and towel kits to people right across Australia who are at risk of or experiencing homelessness. Launched in September 2019, Sheridan staff activate the fundraising, production, and distribution of kits, and StreetSmart connects with local organisations and frontline homelessness services that can provide the kits to people in need.

Often, people accessing frontline homelessness services have very few personal possessions or

practical items, and sourcing this kind of material aid is a constant struggle for organisations. SleepSafe is a unique solution to these challenges, providing quality sheets and towels to vulnerable Australians while also easing the pressure on local frontline organisations to fund and source this material aid. Each Sleep kit consists of a set of sheets, pillowcase, and towel which help provide dignity, comfort, and care to people in crisis.

Through partnering with 643 organisations, SleepSafe is making a difference for thousands of Australians including at-risk youth, Indigenous Australians, Domestic Violence survivors, and

people experiencing housing insecurity. When someone receives a Sleep kit, it is theirs to own, providing care and dignity during a time of high stress and vulnerability.

FROM CRISIS TO COMPORT

"To come from the streets into a property with new linen boosts your self-worth!" - SleepSafe partner in VIC Our community partners are supporting people facing intersecting challenges like homelessness, poverty, domestic violence, and unemployment, and who often seek help with few possessions. As a high quality personal item, Sleep Kits are providing dignity, care, and comfort to people when they need it most. Through our diverse partners, kits have supported over **13,300** at risk youth and young parents, and **23,600** survivors of domestic violence, all looking for a safe place to call home.

"It has been such a help for me moving into my own place for the first time to have brand new sheets and towels. They are so soft and it means a lot that they are mine to keep."

Meet Alex, supported by the Sheridan Store in Moore Park who have fundraised over \$10,000 for SleepSafe.

"19 year old Alex* became homeless after a family breakdown and spent the first 6 months couch surfing with friends. This put pressure on friendships and Alex began sleeping rough and staying in boarding houses. When a local service connected Alex to transitional housing, they had little to their name beside a small bag of belongings. The feeling of comfort and safety when Alex was finally able to climb between soft new sheets of their own and shower with a clean towel was 'unforgettable'"

Meet Bec, supported by the Nunawading Sheridan Store which has fundraised 4,262 kits

Bec (not their real name) came to You Matter for support through a family violence agency with her 2 young children. Bec was fleeing family violence and was seeking support in setting up a new home for herself and children. We had iust received 60 Sleep Kits from StreetSmart and Sheridan and could immediately support Bec by providing her with new sheets and towels for her family. Support like this eases the financially crippling burden that beginning a new life from scratch can hold for families like Bec's.

With the continual growth of SleepSafe partners, the program supports an incredibly diverse range of organisations on the ground in their communities. In 2023 alone, the SleepSafe recipient network has grown by **14**% with over **70** new partnerships, each with their own unique network. We partner with **over 109** Domestic and Family Violence services, **63** Youth services, and **203** neighbourhood and community services who support low-income and at-risk Australians. "Whether it's helping flood affected communities orother recipients including families experiencing homelessness, newly settled families, those escaping family violence or experiencing significant hardship, these items make such a difference."

Mummies Paying It Forward, on Gadigal Country (NSW) By providing small but vital community organisations with free, high-quality manchester, SleepSafe saves our partners valuable time and money.

*Based on feedback provided in a recent partner survey showing that 66% of partners spent on average 3 hours per month sourcing new manchester at a staff cost of \$40 an hour.

*SleepSafe has saved over 14,700 hours of precious staff time and **\$590.400** in wage costs for our partners who provide manchester to their clients*. Without SleepSafe, these partners would pay \$30, on average for sheets and a towel (of a lesser quality), which has saved the sector over 4 million dollars. A third of our partners usually rely on donated and second hand manchester but through SleepSafe, are able to provide their clients with the dignity of higher quality sheets and towels that last

SleepSafe connects communities, empowering Sheridan staff and their customers to raise funds for kits to be donated to their local frontline homelessness services. The program embodies the whole-ofcommunity approach that we strongly believe in to end homelessness.

Since 2019, the Bundaberg Sheridan store alone has raised over \$30,000 for Sleep Safe kits for their local charities, one of which is EDON Place who support individuals and families recovering from domestic and family violence.
