JUL AUG '25	Without a House - Ending Homelessness through housing by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • providing household essentials like furniture • funding operational costs for housing programs • contributing to the creation and upkeep of accommodation/housing units Priority cohorts: young people, those sleeping rough, women
SEP OCT '25	A Fair Go - Responding to poverty by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • providing emergency relief and basic essentials • creating employment and up-skilling opportunities • providing housing support and rent relief Priority cohorts: refugees/non-residents, families, those unemployed
NOV DEC '25	The Tipping Point - Preventing homelessness by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • emergency relief and essential support like rent support, advice and advocacy providing education and employment opportunities access to • health and wellbeing programs mentoring + legal advice Priority cohorts: unaccompanied children, LGBTQIA+, care leavers
JAN FEB '26	SmartCare - Investing in staff & bolstering sector capacity by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • creating opportunities for staff wellbeing, recognition, and support • providing 'self-care' training, upskilling, and external supervision • providing flexible funding in line with <i>Pay What It Takes*</i> Priority cohorts: frontline staff and volunteers <i>*a movement to recognise the full cost of delivering impactful work</i>
MAR APR '26	Through a Gender Lens - Women's Homelessness <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • funding gender-specific accommodation and housing support • providing emergency relief and crisis support • investing in work and employment opportunities Priority cohorts: women escaping violence, women impacted by the justice system, youth, LGBTQIA+, older women
MAY JUN '26	Missing - seeking out those left behind and overlooked by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • funding street outreach services • providing meals, clothing, and essentials • helping provide crisis and long-term accommodation support Priority cohorts: people sleeping rough, migrants, non-residents and refugees, children and youth
