Building confidence with social inclusion opportunities <p>Priority cohorts: young people, migrant and refugee communities</p>

SEP OCT	<p>A Fair Go - Preventing and responding to poverty by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ... providing emergency relief and basic essentials, and healthcare ... employment programs and up-skilling ... providing housing support and rent relief <p>Priority cohorts: refugees/non-residents, systemic poverty for ATSI, exiting prison, young people, those unemployed</p>
NOV DEC	<p>The Tipping Point - Supporting those on the precipice through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ... emergency relief and essential support like rent support, advice and advocacy ... providing education and employment opportunities ... access to health and wellbeing programs ... mentoring + legal advice <p>Priority cohorts: unaccompanied children, trans/LGBTQIA+, care leavers, those leaving prison, migrant and refugee</p>
